
SALVATION

1. GOD'S PLAN - PEACE AND LIFE

The word of God stresses that God loves YOU and wants YOU to experience His Peace and Life. The Bible says... "For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." – John 3:16



God (Holy)




2. YOUR PROBLEM - SEPARATION

Being at peace with God is not automatic because you by nature are separated from God. The Bible says... "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." – Romans 3:23. "For the wages of sin is death but the free gift of God is eternal life in Jesus Christ our Lord." – Romans 6:23

3. GOD'S REMEDY – THE CROSS

God's love bridges the gap of separation between God and man. When Jesus Christ died on the Cross and rose from the grove, He paid the penalty for our sins. Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father; but through Me." – John 14:6

4. YOUR RESPONSE – RECEIVE CHRIST

You respond to God's love by crossing the bridge through trusting Jesus Christ and receiving Him by personal invitation. The Bible says... "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name." – John 1:12

THE INVITATION TO:

Repent (turn from your sins) and by faith receive Jesus Christ into your heart and life and follow Him in obedience as the Lord of your life.

WHAT TO PRAY:

"Oh God, I know I am a sinner. I believe Jesus Christ died for my sins. Right now I repent and turn from my sins. I open the door to my heart and life and receive Jesus Christ as my personal Savior. I thank you now for saving me. Amen."

FULL-TIME MINISTRY

Your decision to commit your life to full-time ministry is of eternal worth to God's mission for the world. In the plan of God for His redemptive work, those entering full-time ministry require a divine call. Therefore, your prayerful handling of this matter will mean much in the eternal ministry of our Lord.

It is God's will for every Christian to be:

- a. Surrendered and separated "For God had not called us for the purpose of impurity, but in sanctification." – 1 Thessalonians 4:7
- b. An active witness

We need to understand that we need to follow the example of Jesus Christ when He said:

"...yet not My will, but Thine be done" – Luke 22:42

Some areas in full time ministry are:

The local church – pastor, evangelist, associate pastor, minister of education, minister of music, minister of youth, director of activities, etc.

Student work – ministers on college and university campuses.

Christian social ministries – work through local churches, centers, homes for aging, children's home, etc.

CHRISTIAN SERVICE

Jesus said, "just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." – Matthew 20:28

Jesus demonstrated with His life on what it means to serve others. He preached the gospel. He showed His disciples the Heavenly Father. He served them with love and humility. And He calls us to do the same.

He said, "If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet." – John 13:14

How do I know what area of service is for me?

"But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift...for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ." – Ephesians 4:7, 12

Here are some guidelines to service and to discovering one's gift:

- Open yourself to God as a channel for His use.
- Examine your aspirations and talents for Christian service.
- Identify the needs that you believe to be the most crucial in the life of your fellowship/church.
- Follow prayerfully the guidance of the Spirit as He leads you into obedience to God.
- Evaluate the results of your service, the growth of others, and your own growth.
- Remain alert to the needs/responses of other Christians.

ASSURANCE OF SALVATION

 (Find a "QUIET TIME" everyday when you can be alone with God your Father.) Jeremiah 33:3, Mark 1:35, Philippians 4:4-7
- Share your faith in Christ with others.
 John 1:35-42, Act 1:8, II Corinthians 5:20
- Allow the Holy Spirit to empower and control your life.
 John 15:5, Ephesians 5:18, Galatians 2:20, Philippians 4:13
- Follow Christ in the believer's baptism and become a member of a church where the BIBLE is faithfully taught and where you can worship.


You say you have received Jesus Christ, but you have failed Him and you are seeking His forgiveness.
